BY-LAW NO. 2007-103

**Being a by-law to appoint a
Closed Meeting Investigator**

WHEREAS Section 239.2 of the *Municipal Act 2001*, c.25, when proclaimed in force, authorizes the municipality to appoint an investigator to investigate in an independent manner any complaint as to whether the Municipality has complied with the Act or a Municipal procedural by-law in respect of a meeting or part of a meeting that was closed to the public and to report on the investigation;

AND WHEREAS in appointing an investigator and in assigning powers and duties to him, a Municipality is to have regard to, among other things:

1. the investigator's independence and impartiality;
2. confidentiality with respect to the investigator's activities;
3. the creditability of the investigator's investigative process;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Tay is satisfied that JGM Consulting has the skills and ability to meet the foregoing criteria;

AND WHEREAS the County of Simcoe has entered into an agreement with JGM Consulting to provide the said investigative services on behalf of the County of Simcoe and any or all member municipalities that appoint JGM Consulting;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TAY ENACTS AND BE IT ENACTED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Council hereby appoints JGM Consulting as an investigator for the purposes of Section 239.2 (1) of the Act.
2. The provisions of this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the 1st day of January, 2008.
