CHANGE IN CANINE CONTROL ENFORCEMENT **EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2010**

The Township of Tay is pleased to announce that starting May 1st, 2010, canine control services will be operated through the Township. Residents with canine control complaints, concerns or queries are requested to call (705) 534-7248 ext 248 effective May 1st and request the Township's Canine Control Municipal Law Enforcement Officer.

In addition, the Township has partnered with the OSPCA for poundkeeping services effective May 1, 2010. As a result, if your dog is impounded/picked-up by the Township after May 1st residents will be required to attend the local OSPCA to pick up their dog at OSPCA Midland & District Branch, 15979 Hwy 12, Port McNicoll, ON.

Township residents are reminded that the Township of Tay has a 2-dog limit and that in accordance with By-Law #2001-73 every owner of a dog shall ensure the dog to be registered with a license by the Township for each calendar year.

First Dog IF neutered/spayed	\$25.00
First Dog NOT neutered/spayed	\$35.00
Second Dog whether or not neutered/spayed	\$40.00
