

**NOTICE TO TAY RESIDENTS  
NEW REGULATIONS  
FOR OPEN AIR BURNING**

The Council of the Township of Tay at their April 14<sup>th</sup> Council meeting adopted By-law 2010-23 being a by-law to change the open air burning regulations. The by-law took effect April 15, 2010.

Below are some of the changes:

- ❑ All open air burning requires a permit, no exceptions. This includes previous inspected fire pits.
- ❑ Two types of burning permits will be issued, being Non-Recreational and Recreational.
- ❑ Both types of permits issued are valid until December 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.
- ❑ All tenants are required to provide written permission from the owner to obtain a burning permit.
- ❑ Hours of burning will differentiate with Non-Recreational & Recreational permits.
